APRIL 8TH IS OUR SPECIAL BOND ELECTION. EVERY REGISTERED VOTER IN THE SCHOOL DISTRICT IS ENCOURAGED TO GET OUT AND CAST YOUR VOTE. THIS SPECIAL ELECTION IS FOR A \$7.5 MILLION BOND WITH A NO MIL INCREASE FROM OUR CURRENT BOND. THIS BOND WILL BE REPAID WITH 51% STATE AID, WHICH MEANS OUR TAXPAYERS WILL PAY FOR A LITTLE LESS THAN HALF OF THIS BOND.
